The USSR had allied itself with the Capitalist West, US and Europe, against Adolf Hitler in the Second World War (1939-45). Even before the end of the war, differences had started to show up between the two leading powers over the issue of the political/socio-economic reconstruction of the postwar world. This kicked off the Cold War between Communist USSR and the Capitalist West, led by the US. ...
